

### ETSA vision statement on safety

- **Vision:** zero accidents at all member firms' sites by:
  - Contributing to building a safety **culture**, concrete safety commitments and continuously improving safety behaviour involving all employees, partners and customers. Learning from mistakes, near misses, ongoing process...
  - Creating a dynamic industry **network** for specialist exchanges, throughout Europe, among safety-minded experts from member firms, partner companies and national associations on accident reduction and **best safety** practices.
  - Creating a benchmarking data set on safety **KPIs**
  
- **Background and milestones**
  - 2016: ETSA Board set up a new ETSA Project Group to define a set of common widely-accepted KPIs (Key Performance Indicators) to measure and benchmark safety performance among member firms, with a view to reducing accidents.
  - 2016: Three Project Group conference calls held to define KPIs and ETSA vision statement.
  - 15 June 2017: ETSA Board on support on principles/first draft.
  - 26 September 2017: Discussion and feedback at first ETSA safety roundtable. Feedback included on 17 October 2017.
  - 21 November 2017: approval of final version by ETSA Board for further publication
